

Chromebooks 2017-18 School Year

Current 9th and 10th grade students had the option last year to purchase a \$25.00 “Insurance.” This was originally a \$25.00 per year protection plan that expired on the last school day. Then there was a 1st incident deductible of \$50.00, 2nd incident deductible of \$50.00, and lastly a \$200.00 fee on the 3rd offence to replace Chromebook. NOW, instead of paying the \$25.00 per year “Insurance Fee” we are converting this \$25.00 fee to a “User Agreement Fee.”

If you paid this fee you are grandfathered in for the 5 years your student is enrolled within Washington County Schools (8th-12th grade).

If you chose not to pay the fee upfront last year or are a new student being enrolled into Washington County School System, you will be responsible for paying \$5.00 per year from this point forward as the User Agreement Fee.

This fee allows you to use the Chromebook for the school year and take it home to complete assignments and tasks from the classroom. Remember this is still the property of Washington County Schools until completion of graduation.

Fees are now discounted from what they were last year and the IT Department will be fixing all Chromebook issues. Fees are as follows:

Screen - \$31

Screen Bezel - \$24.95

Bottom Cover - \$39.95

Camera - \$14

Touchpad - \$29.95

Speakers - \$9.25

Charger with Cables - \$16.75

Keyboard with Cover and Touchpad - \$41.60

*(cannot replace single keys, entire keyboard must be replaced)

Entire Chromebook - \$200.00 for total loss

You are responsible for any and all damage of Chromebook. During the summer the Technology Dept. at the School Board Office is responsible to clear/clean and repair any damage to the Chromebook they find. You will be responsible for any damages not reported during the school year that are found during this process.
